Interested in the Military: Check this out!

- General Requirements for most branches of the Military:
- U.S. Citizen or an immigrant alien legally admitted to the U.S. for permanent residence with immigration and naturalization documents
 - Between the ages of 17-35 (17 needs parental consent)
 - Have a high school diploma
 - Take and pass the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery
 - Pass a medical exam
 - Single persons with one or more minor dependents are not eligible for enlistment into military service
 - Must meet moral character standards designed to screen out persons likely to become disciplinary problems. Standards cover court convictions, juvenile delinquency, arrests, and drug use.
- * Waivers are granted on a case by case basis by individual services for some of the above qualification requirements

 - Physically able to perform the trade
 - HS Diploma or GED
